## Dual Enrollment Policy

Under special circumstances Western Michigan Christian High School will allow students to dual enroll at WMCHS and one additional educational setting. Students may enroll at a local high school (Mona Shores or their district of residence), community college, or other college. To be eligible for consideration for dual enrollment the student must meet the following criteria:

- Student must be on track with the curriculum and must have taken all required course work up to that point.
- Students must have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA
- Students with a GPA below 3.5 must meet with the Guidance Counselor and a parent or guardian for pre-approval before registering for a class.
- Must be a Junior or Senior in good standing with the academic and disciplinary administrations.
- The student must be on track to receive a WMC diploma.
- Must have completed the WMC curriculum in the subject area in which they would like to dual-enroll.
- The course the student wishes to take may not be a course that is currently offered at WMC.

Dual Enrollment opportunities must meet the following criteria:

- Allow students to be on campus at WMC a minimum of three class periods each day.
- Allow students to complete their graduation requirements as set by the Michigan Merit Curriculum (MMC) and WMC School Board.
- Be approved by the Guidance Counselor and Academic Administrator.

Additional Guidelines:

- WMC Transcripts will reflect the grade given by the institution as a transfer credit and but will not be factored into the student's GPA.
- WMC will apply for available State funding each year for dual-enrolled students but cannot guarantee that funds will be available.
- Students are responsible for the cost of books, administrative fees, technology or lab fees, and any tuition not covered by the State.
