Materials to be used in the classroom must meet the following principles:

1. The material helps the students develop a better understanding of his or herself in relation to God and others.
2. The material is consistent with the instructional objectives of the course and the unit being studied.
3. The material is appropriate for the mental, emotional, and spiritual level of the students in class.
4. The material adheres to accepted pedagogical and academic standards for the grade level and content.

Video Selection Policy:

1. All videos must be approved by administration prior to being used as part of the curriculum in any course. Approved videos are listed on the master excel sheet of approved videos.
2. Any video with a PG-13 rating (middle school) or R rating (high school) or with a permission slip notice on the master excel sheet must have a signed parental permission slip for each student prior to viewing.
3. All videos that require a permission slip, must also have an approved alternative assignment for students who choose not to view the movie. The alternative assignment must not be punitive, and must meet the same educational objectives as the movie.
4. All videos with a PG-13 or R rating that have questionable content should have those items addressed prior to showing the movie in class.

YouTube Video Policy:

1. Whenever possible YouTube videos should be viewed through filters (ie: Quiet Tube, Educational Viewers, etc.)
2. All YouTube videos should be applicable to the content being taught and should be evaluated based on the following:
 - a. Language
 - b. Appropriate scenes
 - c. Appropriate music
