The following admissions policy has been adopted to promote standards of admission that are consistent with the school’s mission, philosophy, and vision.

- 1. Those seeking to enroll students at our school will follow this process:**
  - A. Families will fill out application and enrollment forms.
  - B. New families from schools other than our partner elementary schools will meet with administration.
  - C. One supporting family member or guardian is a professed Christian and member of a Bible-believing church.
  - D. Parents or guardians must agree to follow our handbook, recognize WMC’s statement of faith, and agree to support our school in prayer, through volunteerism, and through tuition.
  - E. Students will complete required placement tests to enable appropriate placement. Students and parents must agree that the student will pursue the WMC diploma and all of its requirements.
  
- 2. International Student’s Requirements:**
  - A. Meet the criteria of normal student admission.
  - B. Half of all fees and dues must be paid before August 15. All fees and dues must be paid by December 15 of the current school year.
  - C. Students must have documentation of a host family with a signed financial agreement.
  - D. Students must have a round trip ticket to their home country.
  - E. The student shall provide evidence of acceptable health insurance.
  - F. The student must demonstrate a good grasp of the English language, preferably having completed a successful year in an English language high school.
  
- 3. Students inquiring into our school because of discipline reasons will have an interview with administration.**
  
- 4. Admissions are at the discretion of the principal.**
